**The Members of Parliament Union (Burma)  
on the CREDENTIALS CHALLENGE.**

August 28, 2008.

- 1) In order to abolish the military dictatorship and to implement a genuine federal democratic system in Burma, people of the Union of Burma gave their mandate to the elected members of the Parliament and the winning elected parties including National League for Democracy Party in the 1990 election. Against the will of the public, the military dictatorship unilaterally prepared a “seven step roadmap” and is now preparing to hold elections in 2010 with the aim of nullifying the 1990 election result. As of the members of the parliament who have been chosen by public, we the MPs must continue our historic task to protect the public's genuine wish.
- 2) Therefore, we MPU welcome and recommend the CREDENTIALS CHALLENGE to be filed against the junta to object it representing Burma at the 2008 63<sup>rd</sup> United Nations General Assembly session and object to its right to represent Burma.
- 3) The CREDENTIALS CHALLENGE process is implemented within the mechanism of the UNGA, that 88 nations favorably voted in favour of the pro democracy movement of Burma in the 2007 UNGA and that the legal briefing has been done with the esteemed international legal experts. We the MPU support and will work together with the NCUB on the Credential Challenge Activities. MPU urges all elected representatives who have been given the mandate to represent our people at the 1990 elections, to collaborate in our Credential Challenge Activities.
