## Letter of Felicitation on Daw Aung San Suu Kyi's 62<sup>nd</sup> Birthday Anniversary

Daw Aung San Suu Kyi is a national political leader who has been resolutely struggling in the movement for the democratic rights of the entire people and the rights of self-determination of the ethnic nationalities of Burma, and for the establishment of a genuine federal system.

She was a leading figure in the 1988 democratic movement and one of the leaders of the National League for Democracy (NLD), which won the May 1990 elections. Moreover, she is a Nobel Peace laureate. For that reason, the exclusion of her is totally unacceptable for us.

Though she has been incarcerated unjustly for many years since 1989, she has never wavered in spirit and in her political stand, even for a moment. She remains faithfully as an honest and forthright person and true to the entire people and the movement for the second independence of Burma.

The various political problems existing in Burma today must be resolved justly, based on the will of the people made up of various nationalities. In the negotiation to resolve the problems, the ethnic nationalities as well as Daw Aung San Suu Kyi cannot be sidelined. There is requirement to follow this course, because Daw Aung San Suu Kyi is leader of the NLD, which was given the mandate by the people in the 1990 elections, a democratic leader and a national leader.

The country is in a very dreadful state, at the present. It is extremely urgent to resolve political problems of the country through dialogue. Leaders of the ethnic nationalities and Daw Aung San Suu Kyi must surely be included in the process of dialogue. If this were not done, the situation of the country would deteriorate further and arrive at the state of total disaster.

In conclusion, we demand earnestly the immediate release of Daw Aung San Suu Kyi, all the political prisoners and the resolution of political problems of Burma justly through tripartite dialogue, on the 62<sup>nd</sup> Birthday Anniversary of Daw Aung San Suu Kyi. At the same time, on her 62<sup>nd</sup> Birthday, we wish Daw Aung San Kyi to be happy and healthy and be liberated from incarceration, at the earliest date.
